PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT

Children's sports are supposed to be fun – for the children. Unfortunately, many parents, fans and coaches don't realize that their actions, whether verbal or nonverbal, can have a lasting emotional effect on children. Parents, fans and coaches who follow this simple code can help reinforce what sports are all about... *BEING FUN FOR EVERYONE.*

All parents/guardians with children participating in Prairie Grove PeeWee Athletics must abide by this Parent Code of Conduct. Please read, sign and return prior to leaving the Parent's Meeting.

1. I/We will remember that children participate to have fun and that the game is for youth, not adults.
2. I/We agree to support the decisions of the volunteer coaching staff and understand that they work hard to evaluate the talent levels of all players and position them where they will contribute the most to the team and while best developing their individual skills.
3. I/We agree not to criticize, belittle, antagonize, berate or otherwise incite the coaches, players, cheerleaders, fans and/or opposing team, coaches, cheerleaders or fans verbally or by gesture. Action will be taken in one or more of the following forms for any verbal abuse, physical altercations, intimidation and/or any other "unsportsmanlike" conduct:
 - a. Parent/Guardian/Child(ren):
 - i. will be removed from the game or practice.
 - ii. will be removed for the season.
4. I/We agree not to use abusive or profane language at any time at Prairie Grove PeeWee Athletic function.
5. I/We agree to accept all decisions of the game officials, judges or Conference Officials as being fair and called to the best of their ability.
6. I/We agree to take responsibility for any actions that violate this Code of Conduct by a guest or relative of attending parent/guardian.
7. I/We agree to be financially responsible for Prairie Grove PeeWee Booster Club equipment issued to a player/cheerleader other than normal wear and breakage during games and practice. I/we will reimburse Prairie Grove PeeWee Booster Club for the loss and/or damage to said equipment.
8. I/We agree to abstain from the possession and drinking of alcoholic beverages and the possession or use of any illegal substance at any Prairie Grove PeeWee Athletic function.
9. I/We agree to follow the proper Chain of Command (see attached Parent Complaint Process document) when filing a complaint or voicing my opinion regarding any possible rule infraction or concern and will never question, discuss, or confront coaches at the game field, and will take time to speak with coaches at an agreed upon time and place.
